

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Our Story



Our son, Carter was diagnosed with a spontaneous mutation of Neurofibromatosis (NF) when he was two months old. When Carter was eight months old he had surgery for Hydrocephalus and had an Endoscopic Third Ventriculostomy (ETV) done. Before Carter had his surgery, we didn't look too much into NF. Our physician had explained NF to us and we decided we would do the "wait and see" game.

During our three-week stay in the hospital when Carter was eight months old, We had a lot of time to think. We were scared and realized we wanted to learn more about NF and the effects it might have on our son. We spent countless hours reading books and researching the internet.

We had a desire to network with other families, but had no one to turn to. At that time, we realized the psychological need for local support. After getting home from the hospital feeling relieved and realizing how much help we received from medical professionals, friends and family, we wanted to give back to others by providing a source of information and support and formed NF California with other mom's and friends of NF.

We come from a family that both parents work fulltime, my work schedule has constantly changed over the years to accommodate Carter's needs. Carter was diagnosed with precocious puberty at the age of 5 and was on lupron till he was 15 years old. He has a had several surgeries for plexiforms, had several teachers, therapist, doctors who said he would never run, walk up stairs, ride a bike, read past a 3rd grade level and would never graduate with a diploma. At the age of 3 we had one therapist that told me if he could learn to ride a bike and to swim, there is nothing he will not be able to do. Surrounding our time around others that believed Carter can....

attended a special bike camp- learned to ride a bike

attended early morning tutoring for 7 years Carter graduated with a HS diploma in 2020 attended a gym and now can run up stairs, swim and can do kick boxing without falling.

Despite needing 16 surgeries and multiple types of therapy Carter is happy. He is working a part time jobs and walks a few dogs during the week. The medical intervention he has received has been crucial to his health and the social interaction with the families in California is the emotional support our whole family looks forward to.

We appreciate the opportunity to help others see they are not alone.

This rare genetic disorder affects people of all races, ethnic groups, and both sexes equally. Depending on where tumors grow on your nervous system, they can cause various symptoms such as blindness, deafness, cognitive issues, intense and crippling pain, visible tumors and even death if they turn malignant. NF affects one in every 2,500 to 3,000 births, making it one of the most common rare disorders that most people have never heard of.

In honor of NF Awareness Month, we would like to introduce you to an area NF patient, Carter. Carter's Neurofibromatosis complications started from infancy. From hydrocephalus to tumor resections, he has had fourteen surgeries. Adding in physical and academic therapies, multiple specialist appointments, and radiation has made it difficult for Carter to live the life typical of those in their twenties. He appreciates the times when his body allows him to work at his beloved pizza restaurants, but these jobs often do not hold his position while he heals from surgery. 
